

- On trade 'Ensuring reciprocity and a level playing field'


#### **Key Agriculture Points:**

#### The Strategic Dialogue on the Future of Agriculture:



Developed by 29 stakeholders including COPA, COGECA and CEJA Presidents

#### **Guiding Political Principles** Agreed by Stakeholders:

- 1. Markets should drive sustainability and value creation
- 2. **Dialogue** across the food chain is **critical**
- 3. Time for **change** is now.
- 4. **Technology** must be leveraged to support **transition**.
- 5. Shift to **balanced diets** is essential for transition
- 6. Attractive rural areas are vital to future **food security**, viability of society and **liberal democracy**.



# **Conclusions for Sustainable Animal Agriculture**

- Animal farming must meet consumer expectations, as well as climate and environmental objectives.
- Create an Agricultural Just Transition Fund to support the sector moving forward
- Create harmonised benchmarking for sustainability parameters on EU Farms.
- Revise animal welfare legislation as needed and move towards an EU Wide animal welfare labelling scheme.







# **Changes in the European Parliament 2024-29**



- **EPP** remains the largest **voting power** Pro-European Centrists.
- Significant **losses** for **Greens and Liberals** (Renew) when compared to 2019.
- Growth in more right leaning political groupings Patriots / ECR.
- VDL re-elected with Green support the Green Deal remains intact but needs a viable business case.


